## Garden Tip of the Month: Protecting Plants from Frost

Plants freeze at different temperatures. Some are frost hardy and some freeze and then regrow from the roots in the spring. A quick internet search or call to your local garden center can give you answers about your plants' hardiness.

If there is a freeze warning:

- Cover plants with a sheet or blanket (not plastic), we recommend frost cloth which can be reused year after year. We sell frost cloth in our garden center.
- Tent the frost cloth and weigh down the ends so that the wind doesn't remove it.
- Insulate the roots of the plants with mulch such as cypress bark or crushed pine needles.
- Water the plants before and after the freeze.
